Morgan Sims Artist Statement

This body of work began by looking at palettes my students were using in my painting classes at Elmhurst College. The communal palettes had thick, built-up layers of paint with arrangements of color and brushstrokes that looked both chaotic and beautiful, and inspired how I approached my paintings.

The shapes of these canvases are sort of random. I chose geometric shapes because they hold a relationship with traditional painting, but I also wanted there to be no up and down, and in theory these paintings could be hung in any direction. Like shards or pieces from a larger whole, these paintings are cross sections of movement and texture. The resulting image, like a palette, becomes more happenstance.

My decision to add neon developed in response to the paintings. It is fun to look at a painting and decipher lines or movements between blocks of color that can be attempted in glass. I hope that the neon complements the paintings and vice versa. The title of the show comes from the first painting I started in this series. I think it is a nice way to think about materials (pigments and gasses) as earthly substances, and how amidst human activity, Earth is hiding in plain sight.
